**Guided Pathways Discussion @ LA 242****Nov 24 @ 9:00 am – 10:30 am**

Navigating the complicated path through college is a difficult task for far too many. Students need step-by-step roadmaps and effective and ongoing guidance to “on-time” completion — saving time and money — and significantly boosting their success. Less than 25 percent of full-time associate degree candidates graduate in three years — and only about 10 percent do so in two years. This number drops even lower for part-time students. On average, students spend time taking nearly 80 credits towards achieving a 60-credit Associate degree and more than 63 credits towards earning a 30-degree certificate. This session introduces how America’s community colleges have begun to address these matters through Guided Pathways, and how Guided pathways might inform student success, retention and completion at WCC.
